# A Neighbourhood Development Plan

The Chairman together with Cllr Ferris circulated members with four initial designs for a logo: it was agreed that one of these designs, suitably improved, should feature on all paperwork for the future Neighbourhood Development Plan. Cllr Ferris read aloud a draft notice inviting members of the community to become involved in the process: this was approved. The Chairman reported that she has contacted the Camera Club with a view to enlisting its members' help with photographs of issues and places about which residents feel strongly: the Club is keen to help and has offered to loan its display boards for consultation events. Involving the community with a view to gauging support from the parish as a whole for the creation of a Neighbourhood Development Plan, is the next step.

## **Applications**

PA15/00973 Mr T.Pollard – Erection of a dwelling – land adjacent to Tregarthen, Halwin, Porkellis. Cllr Mrs Warren proposed, Cllr Mrs Hook seconded, all others in favour that this application should be returned with the following observation *Wendron Parish Council believes this application to be for a new home in the countryside in an unsustainable location and therefore requests the Planning Authority to refuse permission for development.* 

PA15/01314 Mr D.Martin – Outline application to erect up to 480 dwellings (to include affordable homes) and means of access (with associated cycle, bus and footpath routes) – land adjacent to Clodgey Lane and Gay's Hill, Helston. Cllr Mrs Warren proposed, Cllr Mitchell seconded, all others in favour that this application should be returned with the following observation Wendron Parish Council is supportive of Helston Town Council's observations on this application. However, should planning permission be granted, it requests that some of the S106/CIL monies accruing is offered to the Parish of Wendron to lessen the impact of additional vehicle journeys through the Parish.

PA15/01380 Trevilges Farm Ltd – Replacement dwelling – Trevilges Cottage, Trewennack. Cllr van den Berg proposed, Cllr Tremayne seconded, two members in favour, all others abstaining, that the Council should support the application. The Chairman abstained from voting and therefore declared that the motion was nullified. The Chairman proposed, Cllr Ferris seconded, all others in favour that this application should be returned with the following
