## WENDRON LAWN CEMETERY REGULATIONS

- 1 The Cemetery is laid out for ease of maintenance on a lawn type principle, so memorials are restricted to headstones only. No kerbstones or chippings on graves are allowed.
- 2 No headstone shall exceed an overall height of 2ft 6in above ground level, the width shall not exceed 2ft 9in and the thickness shall not exceed 6in. Plinths of headstones shall not exceed 3ft in width and 1ft in length.
- 3 All headstones and plinths must be of natural stone.
- 4 All graves should be refilled level with existing ground. It is the responsibility of the undertaker to ensure that spoil is removed from the cemetery, unless otherwise agreed. Turf is to be replaced on graves.
- 5 All equipment used during the course of a burial must be removed as soon as is practicable.
- 6 If a mechanical digger is used to dig graves, it is the responsibility of the undertaker to ensure that any collateral damage is made good and to the satisfaction of the Parish Council.
- 7 No planting of shrubs or flowers is allowed on grave spaces. No memorabilia is allowed on grave spaces.
- 8 No receptacles, other than flower vases specifically designed for the purpose, may be placed on the headstone plinth.
- 9 Small crosses of wood are permitted instead of headstones.
- 10 In the memorial area for cremated remains, no plaques, crosses or stone chippings are allowed. Remains may be buried in caskets of wood. Memorial tablets for the deceased must not exceed the following dimensions: 2ft long and 1ft 6ins wide, and 2ins high at the front 4ins high at the rear. Ashes may be scattered under the trees.
- 11 The design, colour and wording on headstones and tablets must first be approved by Wendron Parish Council.
